

Working and stocking conditions for hooks

For optimal use of our hooks, please follow the storage conditions listed below and the general terms of delivery.

Article 1:

• In case of tomato hooks; The tomato variety and type must be known from the start: inquiry, offer and order.

Article 2:

• In case of tomato hooks; For the heavier tomato varieties (such as medium-, large vine tomatoes, beef tomatoes and "couer de boeuf" tomatoes) we urgently recommend the 3.3 mm hook.

Article 3:

• When there is a heavy planting load expected we strongly advise using 1/1000 rope. If thinner twine is chosen in relation to the weight of the tomato variety, Royal Brinkman cannot be held liable for any consequential damage.

Article 4:

• When lowering the plant, the personnel must guide the plant weight and remove the hook from the crop wire in a controlled manner. Click <u>here</u> to watch our video's on how to hang your hooks in the best way.

Article 5:

• The excessive use of Sulphur or other chemical products (e.g. chlorine) may affect the quality of the twine.

Article 6:

• Always read the instructions method first (for example O-hook) before you start.

Stocking conditions

- Stock the boxes in a dry and chill place, preferably between 15-25 degrees.
- Avoid direct exposure to sunlight or heat sources.
- Stock 24 hours in greenhouse conditions before use.
- Do not use the hooks with chemicals such as pesticides, herbicides or sulfur. This may affect the quality of the twine and hooks.
- When using bio hooks. Let the bio hooks acclimate first and use immediately. The bio hooks cannot be stored for months.
- Sprinkling above or fogging in the greenhouse is bad for the quality of the hooks (especially bio hooks)
